FULL SPECTRUM

IS THIS THE RIGHT PRODUCT FOR YOUR BUSINESS?



Full Spectrum products are those which have undergone little to no refinement. All other products which have undergone some refinement through extraction and purification steps are considered broad spectrum or distillates.

BROAD SPECTRUM

FALLS IN BETWEEN FULL SPECTRUM AND SINGLE ISOLATE PRODUCT.

Perfect example here would be obtaining cannabis oil through CO2 extraction and having it undergo a greater processing method than dried flower products. This in turn will lower amounts of terpene. However, compared to other THC or CBD products (i.e distillates and single isolate), CO2 extracted oils still retains some of the chemical spectrums and therefore is called broad spectrum.



SINGLE ISOLATE

MADE FROM HEAVILY REFINING THE CANNABIS PLANT



The idea here is to extract a single entity chemical such as THC, CBD or individual terpene. Single isolate products can be blended together to make a broad spectrum product...

THC OR CBD DISTILLATES

HEAVILY REFINED, ALMOST PURE EXTRACT OF THC OR CBD

Distillates is produced through a process known as distillation, it is an additional step that follows CO2 or ethanol. During this process, most flavours and fragrance chemicals are removed (i.e terpenes). However, very small amounts of cannabinoids may be found. For this reason, THC or CBD distillates is neither a single isolate nor a broad spectrum product.
